BIG HALL AT NEW TOWN HALL



The New Town Hall was built soon after the Prague New Town was founded in 1348.

The New Town Hall is a complex of several medieval buildings. The eastern tract is the oldest, it is from 1377. The Gothic tower at the corner is from the 14th century as well.

The Big Hall is a historical room, where weddings, other ceremonies but also concerts and exhibitions take place.

On the walls are the remains of wall paintings from the 16th century. In the middle of the hall there are three historical wooden columns.

It is this Big Hall, where unique concerts of Symphony Prague (chamber orchestra) and violinist Miroslav Vilímeč regularly take place.
